PROGRAM PURPOSE:

To assist states and communities in implementing measures to reduce or eliminate the long-term risk of flood damage to insurable structures under the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).

Eligibility

Local Governments that are NFIP communities.

Special Conditions

Twenty-five percent state match required.

To reduce or eliminate long-term risk of flood damage by planning and construction projects.

Yearly, in month prior to end of the federal fiscal year.

Selection Criteria & Decision Authority

State selects grant recipients based upon demonstrated need and comformance with mitigation priorities set forth in Local and State Hazard Mitigation Plans.
